

Legislation that would empower women 2018 2nd Regular Session

House of Representatives

Salman Bills

HB2218 - *contraception; cost sharing prohibition*

Prime Sponsor: Athena Salman

Summary: Prohibits insurance from cost-sharing requirements for oral and long-term contraception, and includes coverage for vasectomies

HB2219 - *crime statistic reporting; requirements*

Prime Sponsor: Athena Salman

Summary: clarifies hate crime reporting requirements by law enforcement to DPS

HB2221 - *family planning; grant distribution; repeal*

Prime Sponsor: Athena Salman

Summary: Repeals mandate that AZ Dept of Health Services apply for Title X grant

HB2222 - *feminine hygiene products; requirements; appropriation*

Prime Sponsor: Athena Salman

Summary: Guarantees female inmates unlimited access to feminine hygiene products

HB2224 - *employers; employee salary history; prohibitions*

Prime Sponsor: Athena Salman

Summary: Prohibits employers from seeking a job applicant's previous salary

HB2227 - *abortion; religious employers; contraception; repeal.*

Prime Sponsor: Athena Salman

Summary: Omnibus bill to repeal all restrictions on abortion and contraception in Arizona

Pending Salman Legislation

- HB to codify Sexual Assault Survivors Bill of Rights
- HB to Prohibit employers from requiring wage nondisclosure and requiring previous salary history
- HB to codify the Dignity for Incarcerated Women Act

House Democratic Caucus Legislation

HB2024 - *firearm sales; transfers; background checks*

Prime Sponsor: Randy Friese

Summary: Requires background checks for guns. Women disproportionately killed by guns in intimate partner violence

HB2052 - *automatic voter registration; licenses; IDs*

Prime Sponsor: Ken Clark

Summary: Voter registration is updated every time an individual changes address with DMV

HB2077 - *public employees; collective bargaining*

Prime Sponsor: Mark Cardenas

Summary: Give public employees the right to collectively bargain compensation and benefits with their employer

HB2103 - *health care providers; religious beliefs*

Prime Sponsor: Pam Powers Hannley

Summary: Requires health care providers to disclose if religious beliefs are superseding evidence based practices in health care decisions for a patient

HB2139 - *experienced teacher retention pilot program*

Prime Sponsor: Randy Friese

Summary: appropriates funding towards teacher retention

HB2140 - *mental health; injunction; firearm possession*

Prime Sponsor: Randy Friese

HB2176 - *consular identification cards; permitted use*

Prime Sponsor: Cesar Chavez

Summary: consular ID is a valid form of ID for the state and political subdivisions

HB2200 - *appropriation; child care subsidy program*

Prime Sponsor: Pam Powers Hannley

Summary: Appropriates funding for childcare subsidies

HB2217 - *TPT; diapers; formula; feminine hygiene*

Prime Sponsor: Daniel Hernandez

Summary: exempts the above from sales tax. Will result in \$11 million loss to the general fund (democrats and stakeholders are split on this bill)

HB2231 - *TANF; child only cases*

Prime Sponsor: Diego Espinoza

Summary: Expands children who are eligible for TANF benefits

HB2232 - *TANF; sanctions*

Prime Sponsor: Diego Espinoza

Summary: reduces Ducey' draconian sanctions in republican TANF restoration to 24 mo.

HB2287 - *child care waiting list; appropriation*

Prime Sponsor: Lela Alston

Summary: provides additional funding for child care subsidies

HB2299 - *domestic violence offenders; firearms; seizure.*

Prime Sponsor: Randy Friese

Summary: removes gun from domestic violence offenders

HB2353 - *state employment; applicants; wage history*

Prime Sponsor: Kirsten Engel

Summary: Prohibits state employers from seeking previous wage history from job applicants

HB2374 - *appropriation; teacher certification*

Prime Sponsor: Charlene Fernandez

HB2375 - *Arizona teacher academy; appropriation*

Prime Sponsor: Charlene Fendandez

HB2392 - *schools; sexual abuse prevention program*

Prime Sponsor: Daniel Hernandez

Summary: Creates sexual abuse prevention program for schools, including special training for teachers

HB2426 - *employment; housing; public accommodations; antidiscrimination.*

Prime Sponsor: Rebecca Rios

Summary; Protects LGBTQ from employment and housing discrimination

HB2436 - *overtime pay*

Prime Sponsor: Richard Andrade

Summary: expands eligibility for overtime pay

HB2441 - *children's health insurance program; modifications*

Prime Sponsor: Kelli Butler

Summary: continues KidsCare even in the event of declining funding from Federal Gov.

HB2443 - *medical services purchase; premiums*

Prime Sponsor: Kelli Butler

Summary: Allows Arizonans to buy into state medicaid system

HB2451 - *diaper changing stations; public restrooms*

Prime Sponsor: Richard Andrade

Summary: Mandates newly constructed public restrooms must have diaper changing stations

HB2454 - *sexual assault; rental agreement termination*

Prime Sponsor: Daniel Hernandez

Summary: expands rental agreement termination to include victims of sexual assault if assaulted at their place of residence (currently allows domestic violence victims to terminate)

HB2465 - *family leave*

Prime Sponsor: Isela Blanc

Summary: Guarantees family leave including small businesses, pay is optional according to employer

HB2467 - *employment; employee work scheduling*

Prime Sponsor: Isela Blanc

Summary: Requires employers to provide predictive scheduling

HB2493 - *driver licenses; gender selection*

Prime Sponsor: Ken Clark

Summary: An individual may choose most appropriate gender on their license instead of defaulting to birth assignment of sex

HCR2003 - *right to work; repeal*

Prime Sponsor: Mark Cardenas

Summary: Amends the constitution to repeal Arizona's status as a right to work state, empowering workers in low wage jobs (two-thirds of minimum wage earners are women)

HCR2011 - *ratification; equal rights amendment*

Prime Sponsor: Pam Powers Hannley

Summary: Ratifies the Equal Rights Amendment

HCR2025 - *marriage requirement; repeal*

Prime Sponsor: Cesar Chavez

Summary: repealing certain marriage requirements

Pending House Legislation

HB to regulate Crisis Pregnancy Centers

HB to provide women up to 12 months oral contraception

HB to provide pregnant women dental care through AHCCCS
